



Setting up a facebook account.

Step 1 is google facebook and fill in the form to Create an account.





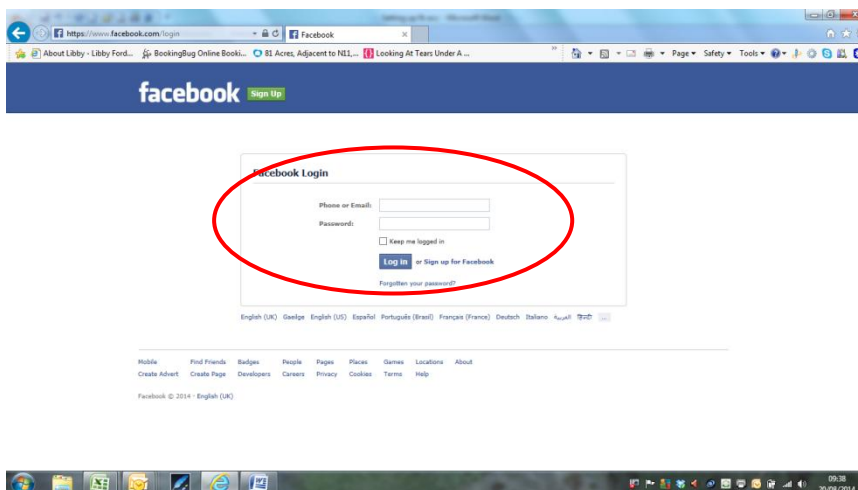
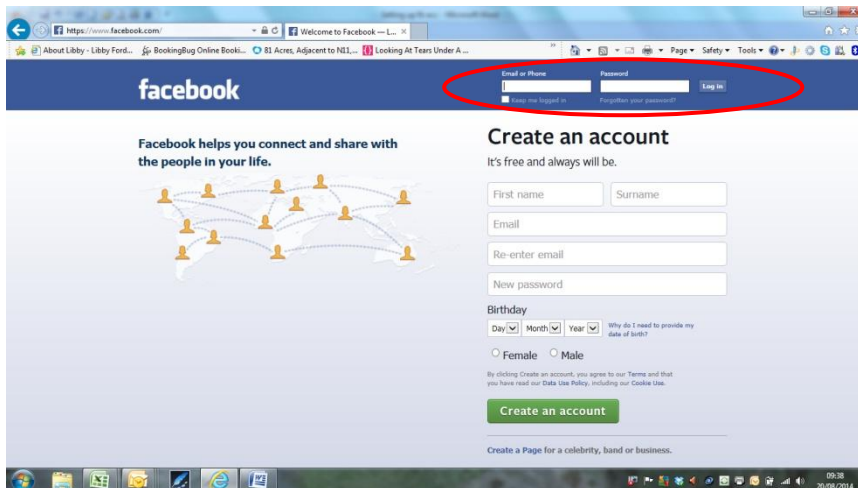

You will be brought through 3 screens to set up your profile. You can skip any steps you don't want to do.

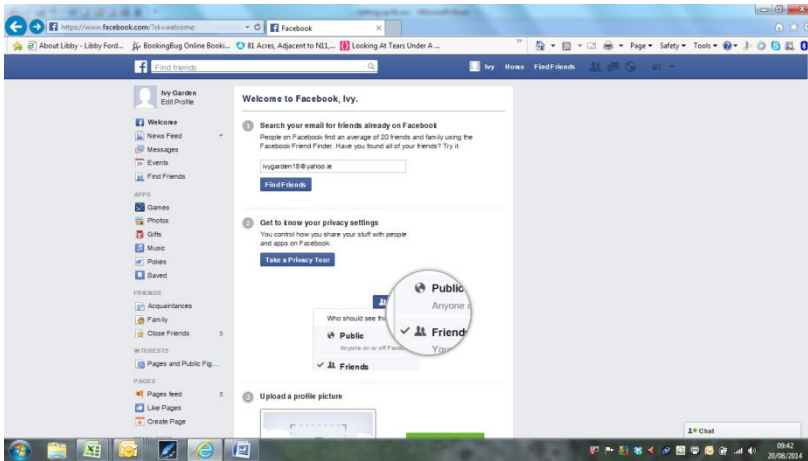

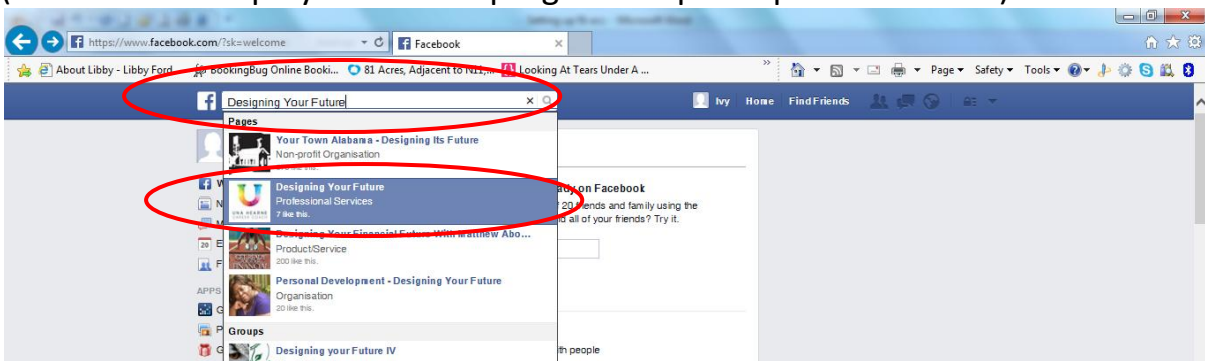
You will be in your profile page. Or, if you exit facebook you can go in again at another time by going to facebook.com and signing in through either of these screens



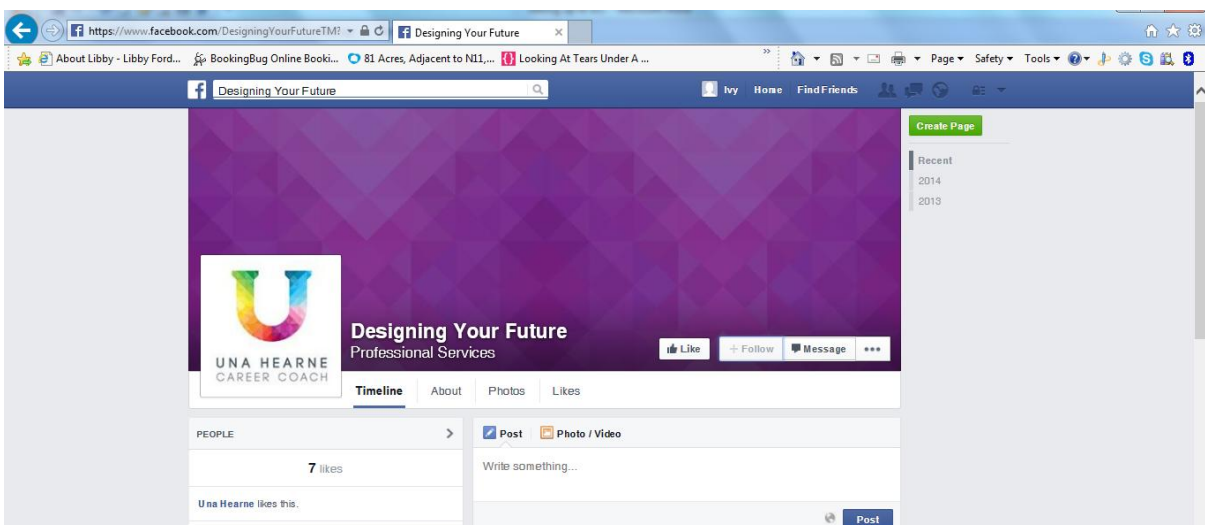
You will automatically be brought to your profile page and encouraged to find friends and facebook will make suggestions based on any information it has.

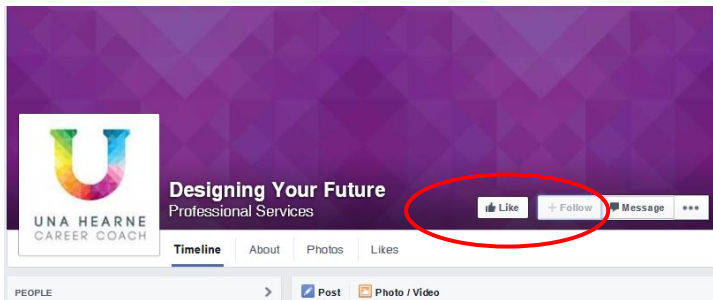
When you click on the listing with my logo you will be brought into the Designing Your Future page
